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Gut health study recalled after zinc levels in tuna miscalculated

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Research that looked into the effect of elevated zinc levels in canned tuna on gut health has had to be re-examined after the journal retracted the study due to 'unreliable data' featured in the paper.

The study, which tested whether mineral levels found in canned tuna was contributing to nutrient absorption issues, was subject to recall earlier this month by the *Food & Function's* executive editor Philippa Hughes.

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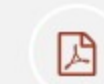


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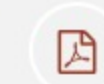
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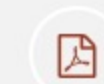
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
